

2023 STOCK GUT AND GO RULES

Promoted by Twisted Metal Derbies

1. Any 1980 and newer 2 wheel drive passenger car/mini-van/mini-truck/mid-size SUV
2. All glass, plastic, and pot metal must be removed. Nothing may remain in the bottoms of the trunk or doors.
3. All outer hardware must be removed- door handles, wheel weights, mirrors, chrome, moldings, screws, fiberglass, etc. No added weights to any car.
4. Rear seats in all cars and all decking in station wagons must be removed.
5. Front seats must be securely bolted to the floor, however, these bolts may **NOT** go thru the frame! You must have a functioning seatbelt.
6. All flammable materials must be removed from the car other than safety padding on the driver's seat. **DASHES AND WIRING MAY BE LEFT INTACTED OR REMOVED.**
7. Gas tank must be mounted securely in back seat area. No bungee cords allowed to secure tanks. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
8. Battery is to be moved to either the passenger front floorboard or passenger seat compartment. Battery must be secured to floorboard. No bungee cords to secure battery. You may extend your battery cables. If computer (ecm) is mounted in fender well it may be mounted to the top of the engine or cowl. It may not be mounted in car unless it came factory inside of car. Wires not being used may be removed.
9. Motor **MUST** still be for that make and model of car. Must run factory throttle cable and gas pedal.
10. **NO HEADERS!**
11. Doors may be fastened down in a max of 6 places with #9 wire or chain.
12. Hoods may be fastened down in a max of 4 places with #9 wire or chain. Wire/chain cannot run in front of the radiator.
13. Trunk may be wired or chained in a max of 4 places.
14. Bumpers should be stock for vehicle.
15. **ROOF SIGN WITH NUMBER RECOMENDED.**
